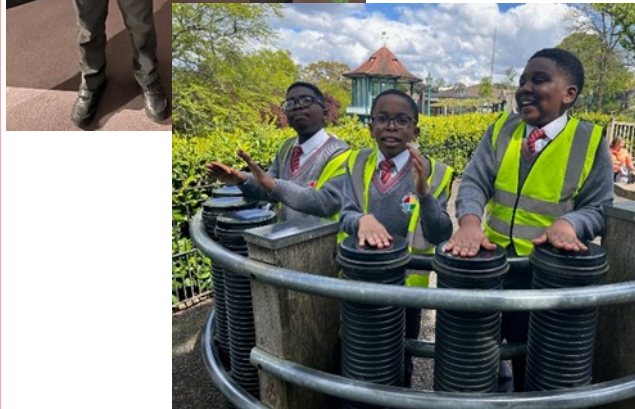
## Safety

## Fr Con's Reflection

Thursday of next week, May 9<sup>th</sup>, is the Solemn Feast of the ASCENSION OF JESUS, OUR LORD. It took place 40 days after His Glorious Resurrection from the dead.



(The Bible References to the Ascension are MARK 16:9-20 and LUKE 24: 50-53).

The sheer wonder of the Ascension points us back unsurprisingly to the sheer wonder of the Resurrection.
