

It costs just £19.15 to feed a child with Mary's Meals every day for a school year. We have managed to feed lunch to 5 children for a whole year, well done children.

This Sunday is GAUDETE Sunday ("Rejoicing" Sunday- from the Latin word).



It signals the imminent end of Phase One of the Holy Season of Advent on 16th December (Monday). In that phase, the emphasis has very much been on Preparation ("Watch!"-"Stay awake!" and such injunction words).

Phase Two of Advent starts on 17th December and lasts up to and including Christmas Eve. Its theme is very different. Following soon upon GAUDETE Sunday, it exhorts us to "rejoice".

So, Advent overall is about both preparing and then rejoicing, in turn.

When we prepare spiritually for the true meaning of Christmas (Jesus' 1st Coming), we are focusing on His 2nd Coming in glory. At the end.
